

CARBONE LORRAINE SIGNS A MAJOR DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT IN HIGH- TEMPERATURE GRAPHITE APPLICATIONS

Various industries, including the aerospace, glass and automotive sectors, use moulds to manufacture some of their products (e.g. turbine blades and dashboards). Electric discharge machining is an advanced technology applied in the mould manufacturing process that uses copper or graphite.

Carbone Lorraine, a specialist in electric discharge machining, and Agié Charmilles, the world leader in electrical discharge machining equipment, have been working together for many years to develop the use of graphite in the spark erosion process. Using graphite instead of copper can reduce machining time by up to 40%.

This partnership has led to an exclusive pan-European distribution agreement for Carbone Lorraine's graphite components, a region where Agié Charmilles has a dominant position and representing business worth up to €10 million.

Under the partnership, Agié Charmilles will make its training centre in the Paris region available to Carbone Lorraine. The deal will broaden the range of services Carbone Lorraine provides to its customers to include training in electrical discharge machining techniques.

Through its emphasis on quality and its extensive range of ultra-fine graphite products, Carbone Lorraine is strengthening its activities in Europe by tapping into new markets for its innovative products and consolidating its expertise to provide a better service to its customers.
